## <u>Order</u>

WHEREAS, the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (hereinafter, "WAPA" or the "Authority") filed a petition on February 16, 2010, with the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter, "PSC" or the "Commission") seeking to raise the Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause ("LEAC") electric factor from \$0.236936 per kWh to \$0.243040 per kWh and to raise the water system LEAC factor from \$9.08 per kGal to \$9.11 per kGal; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2010, the Commission's Technical Consultants submitted their LEAC report and analysis to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2010, the Commission met in a Special Meeting at its offices located at Barbel Plaza, St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands; and

WHEREAS, upon review and deliberation, the Commission voted to increase the electric system LEAC factor to \$0.238997 per kWh and to decrease the water system LEAC factor to \$8.14 per kGal effective on all bills rendered from April 1, 2010 to June 30, 2010; and

## **NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

- 1. The electric system LEAC factor is increased from \$0.236936 per kWh to **\$0.238997** per kWh effective on all bills rendered from April 1, 2010 to June 30, 2010.
- 2. The water system LEAC factor is decreased from \$9.08 per kGal to \$8.14 per kGal effective on all bills rendered from April 1, 2010 to June 30, 2010.
