Order

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2010, the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (hereinafter, "WAPA" or the "Authority") filed a petition with the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter, "PSC" or the "Commission") seeking to raise the Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause ("LEAC") electric factor from \$0.260853 per kWh to \$0.274412 per kWh and to raise the water factor from \$8.61 per kGal to \$11.47 per kGal; and

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2010, the Commission's Technical Consultants submitted their LEAC report and analysis to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2010, the Commission met in regular session at the Port Authority Conference Room located at the Henry Rohlsen Airport, St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands; and

WHEREAS, upon review and deliberation, the Commission voted to decrease the electric system LEAC factor to \$0.251336 per kWh and to increase the water system LEAC factor to \$10.04 per kGal effective on all bills rendered from July 1, 2010 to September 30, 2010; and


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The electric system LEAC factor is decreased from \$0.26853 per kWh to **\$0.251336** per kWh effective on all bills rendered from July 1, 2010 to September 30, 2010.
2. The water system LEAC factor is increased from \$8.61 per kGal to **\$10.04** per kGal effective on all bills rendered from July 1, 2010 to September 30, 2010.
