Order No. 57/2010

ORDER

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 30, Section 25 of the Virgin Islands Code, all Virgin Islands public utilities are subjected to periodic assessments of fee by the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter, "PSC" or the "Commission") based on a formula related to gross operating revenues and the territorial gross revenues of all public utilities; and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2010, the Commission met in a special meeting at its offices located at Barbel Plaza, St. Thomas, U. S. Virgin Islands; and

WHEREAS, after careful review and deliberation and the recommendations of its staff, the Commission voted to make the following annual assessment fees on the listed public utilities; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 6924, the Virgin Islands Legislature extended solely to the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (“WAPA”) the right to pay its annual assessments in equal quarterly instalments; and

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED**, that the listed public utilities pay the fiscal year 2010 fees within twenty (20) days of the date of this order to be deposited in the Treasury of the United States Virgin Islands in a special account to be maintained and administered by the Commissioner of Finance designated Special Public Utility Deposit Account as prescribed by law.
