WHEREAS, on February 26, 2009, the Commission voted to commence an evidentiary hearing pursuant to Title 30, Section 47 of the Virgin Islands Code; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2009, the PSC voted to appoint Rosalie Simmonds Ballentine, Esquire as Hearing Examiner for Docket 579; and

WHEREAS, public hearings were held on St. Thomas, U. S. Virgin Islands on May 12-13, 2009; and

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2009, the Hearing Examiner filed her final Report and Recommendations with the Commission; and

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2009, the Commission met in regular session at its offices located at Barbel Plaza, St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands; and

WHEREAS, upon review and deliberation, the Commission voted to postpone its decision on IWP's interconnection application for thirty (30) days; and

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Commission's decision on the interconnection application of IWP is postponed for a period of thirty (30) days.
