**WHEREAS**, on September 26, 2008, Island Wind Power, Inc. (hereinafter "IWP") filed an application with the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter "PSC" or "the Commission") for interconnection with the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (hereinafter "WAPA" or "the Authority") pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 2 of the Virgin Islands Code; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 26, 2009, the Commission voted to commence an evidentiary hearing pursuant to Title 30, Section 47 of the Virgin Islands Code; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 23, 2009, the PSC voted to appoint Rosalie Simmonds Ballentine, Esquire as Hearing Examiner for Docket 579; and

**WHEREAS**, public hearings were held on St. Thomas, U. S. Virgin Islands on May 12-13, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 25, 2009, the Hearing Examiner filed her final Report and Recommendations with the Commission; and


**WHEREAS**, on September 29, 2009, the Commission met in regular session at its offices located at Barbel Plaza, St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands; and

**WHEREAS**, upon review and deliberation, the Commission voted to postpone its decision on IWP's interconnection application for thirty (30) days; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Commission's decision on the interconnection application of IWP is postponed for a period of thirty (30) days.
