ORDER

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2009, the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (hereinafter "WAPA" or "the Authority") filed a petition with the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter "PSC" or "the Commission") requesting to raise the Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause ("LEAC") electric factor from \$0.222393 per kwh to \$0.236936 per Kwh; and to raise the water system LEAC factor from \$8.19 per kgal to \$9.08 per kgal; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2009 the Commission's Technical Consultants submitted their LEAC report and analysis to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the price of oil has continued to rise; and

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2009, the Commission met in regular session at its offices located at Barbel Plaza, St. Thomas, U. S. Virgin Islands; and

WHEREAS, after review and deliberation, the Commission voted to increase the electric system LEAC factor to \$0.257272 per Kwh and to increase the water system LEAC factor to \$10.41 per Kgal effective on all bills rendered from January 1, 2010 to March 31, 2010; and


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The electric system LEAC factor is increased from \$0.222393 per Kwh to \$0.236936 per Kwh on all bills rendered from January 1, 2010 to March 31, 2010.
2. The water system LEAC factor is increased from \$8.19 per Kgal to \$9.08 per Kgal effective on all bills rendered from January 1, 2010 to March 31, 2010.
